

Community Eye Service Glaucoma Service Flo Integration

Purpose

- To improve patient compliance with prescribed drops regime
- To improve patient outcome by earlier stabilisation
- Reduce frequency of patient attendance by improving ability to self-manage

Selection of patients

- · Patients struggling with current regime
- · Patients newly prescribed drops

Expected outcomes

- Reduction in number of patients not able to comply with drops regime
- Improvement in rates of stability
- Improvement in rates of stability at an earlier point
- Reduction in review appointments with ophthalmologist

Protocol

Overview

- Flo is explained to patient following prescription of glaucoma drops and they are invited to join the project.
- Reminders to instil drops are texted to patients, daily at first then reducing to monthly and stopping.
- · Patient will be asked to contact the clinician if they are struggling with the regime
- At follow up appointment patient will be able to start receiving reminders again if they are still struggling

Patient

- Signs contract agreeing to accept message from Flo until follow up appointment
- Receives regular messages and tries to adhere to treatment regime
- Interacts with Flo to get the most from the experience
- Attends follow up appointments and contacts clinic as advised.

Service

- Enrols patient using mobile number and NHS number
- Provides advice and leaflets
- Provides information on how to contact the service
- Holds record of patients enrolled on project

Staff

- Will support patients engaged with project
- Complete a questionnaire at beginning and end of project

Messages

Days 1-7

Hi, it's Flo. This is your reminder to use your Glaucoma drops as prescribed today, take care

Day 8

Hi, it's Flo. Don't forget your Glaucoma drops today. If you have had any problems you can ring the clinic on xxxxx. I'll be in touch next week.

Day 15

Hi, it's Flo. Have you remembered your Glaucoma drops every day? Reply with No if you haven't, otherwise I'll be in touch next week.

<u>Reply No</u>: It's very important to instil the drops regularly, please refer to the leaflet we gave you and I will be in touch week to see how you are getting on

Day 22

Hi, it's Flo. Have you remembered your Glaucoma drops every day? Reply with No if you haven't, otherwise I'll be in touch next week.

<u>Reply No</u>: The most likely cause of vision loss for people diagnosed with glaucoma is not using drops as prescribed; I'll be in touch again next to see how you're doing

Day 29

Hi, it's Flo. Have you remembered your Glaucoma drops every day? Reply with No if you haven't, otherwise I'll be in touch next month

<u>Reply No</u>: I am sorry you are still struggling to use your drops everyday, perhaps some support would help? Call the clinic and ask for advice. We may need to see you.

Day 59
